

## TNT 2012 obtains the EPS Sponsored Conference label

Madrid (Spain): 29 May 2012

The 13<sup>th</sup> edition of the Trends in Nanotechnology International Conference (<u>TNT 2012</u>) to be held from the 10<sup>th</sup> until the 14<sup>th</sup> of September 2012 will be sponsored by the European Physical Society (EPS).

This high-level scientific meeting aims to present a broad range of current research in Nanoscience and Nanotechnology (N&N) as well as related policies or other kind of initiatives. Currently, 30 keynote <u>speakers</u> from all over the world, covering different fields of Nanotechnology, are confirmed.

Considering TNT 2012 is an EPS sponsored conference, their members qualify for a reduced fee at the event. The early bird fee is 400 € until the 20<sup>th</sup> of June 2012 and after that date 485 €. This fee includes admission to all conference sessions, the exhibition, program and conference abstract book, conference material, welcome reception, conference dinner and coffee breaks.

Furthermore, an <u>EPS Poster Prize</u> (amount 250€) will be awarded to a PhD student who presents the best poster at the conference, along with other 8 prizes.

The call for abstracts is still open and the deadline is the 4<sup>th</sup> of June 2012.
