

Graphene one-day Symposium organized within TNT2013

Madrid (Spain): July 8, 2013

On the occasion of TNT 2013, the 14th edition of the Trends in Nanotechnology International Conference (<u>TNT 2013</u>), a Graphene one-day Symposium will be organized in Seville (Spain) at Hotel Silken Al-Andalus Palace.

This one-day event will be organized in collaboration with ICN2 (Spain) and will take place on September 10.

The Graphene Day entails a plenary session during the morning and the afternoon session will be divided in track A (**Graphene science driven oral contributions**) and track B (**Graphene driven applications** Keynotes & Graphene Flagship dedicated session).
